On 12th May 2023, we completed 35 glorious years of working towards empowering women and children. We are both proud and humbled by our journey and the impact we've made through our thematic areas of Inclusion, Education, Early Years Intervention, Anti-Human Trafficking and Women Empowerment. The legacy of a visionary social worker and our founder Mrs Kadri continues to inspire us to achieve our Vision of India as a Child-friendly Nation. What started as a small school for children with disabilities at YMCA, Andheri is now an organization working in different regions of Maharashtra, Delhi, Goa, Gujarat and Himachal Pradesh. In the last 10 years alone, we have directly impacted the lives of over 5.2 lakh beneficiaries across 5 states.

We at Vipla Foundation envision India as a Child-Friendly Nation where nothing stops our children from Learning Growing and Flourishing and our interventions are focused towards this. We work on prevention and early interventions to improve the quality of lives of our beneficiaries particularly those who come from marginalized and excluded communities.

Our Special School for children with hearing impairment and intellectual disability focuses on providing quality education that looks at the all-around development of children so that they can go on to lead a life of dignity and economic independence.

Through early detection of hearing impairment, our Dhvani program provides diagnosis, Pre and Post cochlear implant management, therapy and support to hearing-impaired children so that they can be mainstreamed into regular schools.

The Early Years Intervention focuses on building a strong educational foundation for young children through Balwadi's and teacher mentorship programs so as to prepare children for school through a developmentally appropriate curriculum that also prepares children to be school ready. The Patang Remedial education program focuses on improving grade-level competencies of children who are lagging behind and also advocating and supporting systemic change in school ecosystems through School Transformation programs.

Our work with women is aimed at Prevention, Protection, Prosecution, and Policy advocacy for Anti Human Trafficking. By economically empowering women most prone to Genderbased violence we aim to reduce its devastating intergenerational impact so as to break confirmation to gender role norms in India thereby paving the way for better opportunities for young girls in the future.
